ECO-FRIENDLY MAPPING is a project focused on the environment, waste management and greenhouse gas emissions. The educational centres in the Netherlands (Rotterdam), Italy (Udine) and Spain (Toledo) take part in the project, in collaboration with geolocation company Here Maps.

We started this project in 2020, but then we had to switch into digital meetings because of the COVID. After this difficult period we managed to see each other and work together. Firstly in Udine (7-12 February 2022), then in Rotterdam (8-14 May 2022) and finally in Toledo (26 September - 1 October 2022).

The aims of this work are:

- environmental awareness
- development of ICT skills
- acquisition of a European awareness
- improvement of language skills
- promotion of healthy activities for social inclusion

We have carried out studies on air and water quality and on waste management in the cities of the participating centers.

Being aware of the environmental situation in our cities, we ask our governments for the following:

- More bike lanes (Toledo and Udine)
- More parks and green places
- There should be more water treatment plants
- More electric cars and charging points
- More trash cans per street (Rotterdam)
- More sustainable treatment for tap water: reverse osmosis, distillation or through ion exchange resin
